in an introduction to classical econometric theory paul a ruud shows the practical value of an intuitive approach to econometrics students learn not only why but how things work through geometry seemingly distinct ideas are presented as the result of one common principle making econometrics more than mere recipes or special tricks in doing this the author relies on such concepts as the linear vector space orthogonality and distance parts i and ii introduce the ordinary least squares fitting method and the classical linear regression model separately rather than simultaneously as in other texts part iii contains generalizations of the classical linear regression model and part iv develops the latent variable models that distinguish econometrics from statistics to motivate formal results in a chapter the author begins with substantive empirical examples main results are followed by illustrative special cases technical proofs appear toward the end of each chapter intended for a graduate audience an introduction to classical econometric theory fills the gap between introductory and more advanced texts it is the most conceptually complete text

for graduate econometrics courses and will play a vital role in graduate instruction
